# MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear SIRE Community,

I am honored to report that because of your support and a lot of hard work by the staff and volunteers, SIRE again made tremendous progress on our 5-year plan during the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

We are close to completing the \$3.5 million improvements to the Spring facility. In September we moved into the LGI Homes Education and Visitors Center, the barn is nearing completion and the arena is well underway. I cannot give enough thanks to all the supporters who made this transformation possible. If you haven't yet had a chance to see the additions, please contact Joe Wappelhorst and make plans for a visit.

In the late summer of 2021 SIRE acquired a 'forever home' for Fort Bend in Fulshear, TX. The acreage, barns and arena have 'good bones' but are aging. We moved in, got up and running, and have made significant strides in updating this facility. A multitude of individuals and corporate volunteers have contributed countless hours and supplies helping with the move and needed maintenance. If you are a handy person and would like a physical project, we sure could use your help out there!

These improvements open the door to serving many more clients, so the need for volunteers, horses and donations is more pressing than ever. Please know that your gift of funds, assets or time directly results in more people served.

2022 saw the kick-off of our Equine-Assisted Services to veterans. Through partnerships with Camp Hope and Easter Seals, SIRE is now serving over 50 military veterans per week. Demand for this service is high, and SIRE is working hard to find the resources to meet this demand. Additionally, SIRE served 180 people per week via traditional therapeutic riding and 45 young people per week through Equine-Assisted Learning.

On behalf of the SIRE board, I want to thank the people who make all this possible:

- The incredible staff at SIRE have shown tremendous adaptability through this time of growth and change. Their dedication and passion for serving our clients is truly an inspiration.
- Volunteers are the heart and soul of SIRE! It takes hundreds of volunteers each week to provide the high-quality programs that SIRE is known for. Whether it is three hours one time fixing a broken pipe or 200 hours per year as a weekly side walker or leader, their contributions enable the everyday miracles experienced by those we serve.

# THE IMPACT OF SIRE SOPHIA STARTED RIDING IN 2016



Thanks to the dedication and support of our volunteers, foundations, corporations, and many individuals, SIRE continues to provide life-changing programs for riders like Sophia. Back in 2016, when Sophia first started riding at SIRE, she had difficulty controlling her energy and emotions. She also had difficulty staying focused.

The short-term goals set for Sophia by the evaluator were to learn to use her hands quietly and smoothly, and to meet and talk to a new friend. Sophia's long-term goals were to ride independently and to compete in shows. It didn't take long for Sophia to accomplish her goal of competing in shows and at Top Hands this year she won a buckle in her English Equitation class. She is also able to focus consistently so that she rides with the lead rope tied up for a good portion of the class.

About a year later, Sophia's mom shared that Sophia's focus has improved and did within the first 6 weeks of riding. Mom has observed a much greater ability to follow directions. Additionally, she reported that Sophia's ability to hold a pencil has grown and her handwriting has not only improved but blossomed to a point that it is legible and getting smaller continually.

Sophia's horse played a critical role in her success. SIRE maintains a wide variety of horses to meet the physical and emotional needs of each rider. Each horse is specially trained to handle an array of noises, quick motions, and unexpected actions that can arise during any session. The bond between a human and a horse is pivotal to the success of therapeutic riding.




